National Grid’s Reply to WED Correspondence dated May 25, 2016**

Dear Ms. Massaro:

On behalf of National Grid,¹ I write in response to Petitioners, ACP Land, LLC and Wind Energy Development, LLC’s correspondence dated May 25, 2016 in the above-referenced docket. In the May 25 letter, Petitioners stated in part that that they have no objection to the Company’s proposed modifications to the Distributed Generation Interconnection Tariff (Tariff), which the Company filed on May 11, “upon National Grid’s representation that these changes will not require customers to definitively determine which program they will enroll in (renewable energy growth, net metering or other) or, which customer accounts will receive net metering credits at the time of the interconnection application.” To clarify, National Grid does require customers to determine which program they will enroll in when completing the interconnection application. This requirement was already included in the revised Tariff that the PUC approved on January 15, 2016. This requirement does not mean, however, that customers may not later change their program selection after they complete the application. Petitioners are correct that, at the time of the application, customers are not required to definitely determine which customer accounts will receive net metering credits, although the Company prefers to receive this information at the time of the application. Counsel for National Grid has discussed this matter with Counsel for Petitioners, who has indicated that he understands this clarification.
