REPORT AND ORDER

On May 15, 2015, The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid filed with the

Public Utilities Commission (PUC) its semi-annual Long-Term Contracting Recovery Factor for

the period July 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. In its filing, National Grid estimated that

the six-month contract cost for twenty-three renewable energy contracts, including twenty-one

distributed generation contracts and two non-distributed generation contracts, would be

\$19,496,757. All but one contract are expected to cost more than the market prices, resulting in a

loss to National Grid. That loss is offset slightly by one non-distributed generation contract, which

is expected to cost less than the market prices. The difference between the estimated contract costs

and net market value is \$4,606,557 in above-market cost.² When this credit is divided by National

Grid's forecasted kWh deliveries for the upcoming six-month period, and adjusted for

uncollectibles, the result is a proposed Long-Term Contract Recovery Factor of 0.23 cents per

kWh. This is an increase of 0.173 cents per kWh from the currently effective factor.³ The impact

on a residential customer using 500 kWh per month is an increase of 90 cents per month.⁴

On June 12, 2015, the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers filed with the PUC a

memorandum summarizing the filing and recommending approval of the proposed credit factor

for effect on July 1, 2015.⁵ At an open meeting held on June 15, 2015, the PUC reviewed the filing and, after finding good cause under R. I. Gen. Laws § 39-3-12 to waive a hearing, approved the proposed Long-Term Contract Recovery Factor to apply to electricity consumed on and after July 1, 2015.

Accordingly, it is hereby,

(21946) ORDERED:

The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid's Long-Term Contract Recovery Factor of 0.230 cents per kWh is hereby approved. The new rate shall apply to electricity consumed on and after July 1, 2015.
