RE: The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid Tariff Advice Filing for Renewable Energy Growth Program and Solicitation and Enrollment Process Rules Docket No. 4536-A

Dear Ms. Massaro:

Please find below a proposal by National Grid¹, addressing an issue raised at the March 9, 2015 evidentiary hearing in Docket No. 4536-A. As indicated at the hearing, the Company is proposing a revision to its proposed Renewable Energy Growth (RE Growth) Program for Non-residential Customers, RIPUC No. 2152 (Tariff). The proposed revision would provide for an extension, without penalty, for RE Growth Applicants that could not meet the deadlines established in the Tariff for commercial operation when the cause of the delay was solely due to the non-completion of the necessary system modifications and interconnection facilities on the Company's side of the meter.

Therefore, the Company proposes that the following language be added to Section 3, Performance Guarantee Deposit, of the Tariff:

[Added to the end of Section 3(f)] "Prior to the expiration of the timeframe applicable to the Applicant's DG Project, as specified herein Section 3(d) or as extended as provided for by Section 3(f), the Applicant must notify the Company of its election to extend the DG Project deadline.

g. In the event that the Applicant has demonstrated material progress with respect to the interconnection process and has complied with all requirements listed in the Interconnection Service Agreement for their project including, if necessary, making full payment for System Modifications in addition to any payments that may be required under this tariff to participate in the RE Growth



Program, and the Applicant is unable to provide the Output Certification within the timeframe specified in Section 3(d), or as extended pursuant to Section 3(f), and the Applicant and the Company agree that the cause of the non-performance under Section 3(d) or Section 3(f) was solely due to the non-completion of the necessary system modifications on the Company's side of the meter, the Company will extend the deadline, with no additional deposit required, for providing the Output Certification until such time as the DG Project has received approval from the Company to interconnect to the Company's distribution system."

If the Commission approves the inclusion of this language in the Tariff, the Company will submit a compliance Tariff following the Commission's decision in this proceeding to reflect the change to Section 3.
