

**PETITIONERS SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE
TO ARBITRATOR'S DECISION**

The Town of Coventry, the Town of West Warwick, WED Coventry One, LLC, WED Coventry Two, LLC, WED Coventry Three, LLC, WED Coventry Four, LLC, WED Coventry Five, LLC and WED Coventry Six, LLC (collectively Petitioners) hereby supplement their response to the arbitrator's decision in this docket. The relief sought in items one through four of the Petitioners' prayer for relief are now resolved through negotiation of the parties. Petitioners' projects, Coventry 1-6, are now on a viable path to interconnection thanks, in part, to this Petition. There is no reason to dedicate more resources to revisiting the arbitrator's factual or legal findings when the relief requested for these interconnections has now been achieved through negotiation.


Petitioners' initial response to the arbitrator's decision asked the Commission to investigate whether an inherent conflict of interest makes National Grid unfit to independently control interconnection in Rhode Island. Such an investigation would shed new light on the facts and law presented in this Petition. It would also lead the Commission to instigate measures that would improve the administration of interconnection moving forward, thereby facilitating the achievement of our State's policy goals and the development of our new energy economy. However, in the aftermath of the procedural conference held on May 19, Petitioners' have resolved that they do not have the will or time to continue dedicating resources to this advocacy right now. The Commission

understands its role and responsibility with regard to interconnection and the energy market and it can and should dedicate its own resources to such an investigation if/as it deems necessary and appropriate. Petitioners may renew this request if the Commission does not act on its own and future interconnections warrant renewed advocacy.

Petitioners will seek implementation of the arbitrator's recommendations in this docket as part of the proceeding to amend the interconnection tariff in Docket 4483.


