

POSITION MEMORANDUM OF THE TOWN OF CUMBERLAND

Pursuant to the procedural schedule established in this matter, and pursuant to Rule 1.20(k), the Town of Cumberland hereby files its position memorandum in this docket.

The Public Utilities Commission previously approved a third step increase of 3.8%.

Pawtucket Water Supply Board (PWSB) filed a compliance filing on May 9, 2017. The filing sought to implement the third step with a 2.3% increase.

Based on the Town's review of the filing, PWSB's responses to the Town's data requests, and input from the Town's expert consultant, the Town supports the adjustment set forth in the Division's June 19, 2017 Position Statement and does not otherwise oppose the third step increase requested by PWSB.
