# Request:

Please provide the amount that the proposed access charge would have had on a stand-alone facility that was previously awarded a distributed generation standards contract between 2011-2014. Please provide at least six (6) examples. In the examples, please include the 3.71 megawatt solar system that the City of East Providence installed in 2013 and the 500 kilowatt anaerobic digestion system being installed in North Kingstown.

## Response:

Please see the Company's response to PUC 1-18. In this response, DG units 11 and 32 represent the 3.71 megawatt solar system that the City of East Providence installed in 2013 and the 500 kilowatt anaerobic digestion system being installed in North Kingstown, respectively. Please note that the nameplate kW provided for DG unit 11 represents alternating current (AC). A 3.71 megawatt direct current (DC) solar project with an 80% de-rate from DC to AC equals 3 MW AC.
