National Grid has an electrical distribution system that was designed and built around centralized power production mainly oil, coal, natural gas and nuclear power..

1. It is out dated and costly to operate and maintain. The high voltage lines feeding sub stations need to be replaced with battery storage at their sub stations with thousands of small to medium size renewable energy systems.
2. Therefor there is no justification for the proposed tariff on standalone renewable energy projects to pay for an antiquated electrical distribution system.
3. The vast majority of standalone renewable energy systems are to the load side of a substation and do not use high voltage lines feeding that same substation.

The tariff should be on power generators such as oil, coal, natural gas and nukes that use hundreds of miles of high voltage lines feeding sub stations and not small to medium size renewable energy systems.
