

March 9, 2016 Data Request of the Commission to A&R Marine Corp**

March 25, 2016

1. The effective date of the rate changes will be determined by the PUC as part of its open meeting decision.
 - a. What is A&R Marine's position on the effect of advanced purchased reduced fare multi-use car tickets?
 - b. Does A&R Marine plan to charge the increase after the effective date of the rates in this case or will it honor those advance purchases?
 - c. Does A&R Marine plan to apply any proposed expiration dates to previously purchased tickets?
 - d. Please provide A&R Marine's proposed policy with regard to any advance purchase tickets and the effect of rule changes or rate changes after the effective date.

RESPONSE:

- a) **The company's position is to charge the additional approved rate on any advanced purchased tickets redeemed after the effective date of the rate increase.**
- b) **Yes. A&R Marine plans to charge the increase after the effective date for all advanced purchased tickets.**
- c) **Yes. Multi-use passenger tickets already have an expiration date, therefore no additional action will have to be taken for these tickets. However, the multi-use vehicle tickets do not currently have an expiration date on the face of the tickets. A&R is proposing to apply the effective date to any previously purchased advanced multi-use vehicle tickets as the starting point for the proposed expiration periods. The expiration periods are detailed in A&R proposed terms and conditions filed with Mr. Bebyn's supplemental testimony.**
- d) **A&R's proposed policy regarding advanced purchased tickets is detailed in Rule 95 of A&R's proposed terms and conditions filed with Mr. Bebyn's supplemental testimony. For rate changes approved after the effective date, as mentioned in response (a) above A&R, proposes to charge the additional rate on any advanced purchases tickets redeemed after the effective date of the rate increase.**
