**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to the provisions R.I.G.L. § 39-1-1 and 39-3-11, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will conduct a hearing on **Monday, February 22, 2016 @ 9:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A of the PUC's office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island.

In this docket, the PUC will examine the propriety of a filing by The Narragansett Electric d/b/a National Grid seeking approval of proposed Electric Infrastructure, Safety and Reliability Plan for FY 2017 (Plan). The Plan is designed to enhance the safety and reliability of the Company's electric distribution system. The Plan is submitted to comply with the provisions of R.I.G.L. § 39-1-27.7.1, which provides for an annual infrastructure, safety and reliability spending plan for each fiscal year and an annual rate reconciliation mechanism that includes a reconcilable allowance for the recovery related to capital investments and other spending undertaken pursuant to an annual pre-approved budget. The Plan would account for a total net incremental increase in revenues of approximately \$6.1 million that would be funded through implementation of proposed Infrastructure, Safety and Reliability (ISR) factors effective April 1, 2016. The bill impact on a residential customer receiving Standard Offer Service and using 500 kWh per month is a monthly increase of \$0.61, or 0.6%. The impact on other customers will vary based on customer class. The PUC may approve different rates that may be higher or lower than those proposed by National Grid.
