

BIPCo to the newly created Block Island Utility District has not yet occurred; (2) a pending lawsuit brought by BIPCO's minority shareholder, Sara McGinnes against BIPCo, the Town of New Shoreham and the Block Island Utility District; and (3) the Utility District has not yet finalized negotiations for financing to acquire BIPCO's stock or assets.

Accordingly, it is

(23304) ORDERED:

The Block Island Power Company is granted an extension of time to October 1, 2018 in which to file its full rate case with a fully allocated cost of service study.


