MOTION TO INTERVENE OF THE NARRAGANSETT ELECTRIC COMPANY d/b/a NATIONAL GRID

Pursuant to Rule 1.13 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Public Utilities Commission (PUC), The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid (National Grid), respectfully files this Motion to Intervene in Docket 4609. On March 11, 2016, the Energy Facility Siting Board (EFSB or Board) designated the PUC to render an advisory opinion in EFSB Docket No. SB-2015-06. As a result of this designation, the PUC opened Docket 4609. In its Application to the EFSB to site a 900 megawatt (MW) gas-fired combined-cycle electricity generating facility in Burrillville, Rhode Island, Invenergy Thermal Development LLC (Invenergy) represented that its generating facility will connect to National Grid's Switching Station via a new 6-mile long electric transmission line to be installed and owned by National Grid. National Grid's interconnecting 6-mile transmission line is a Major Energy Facility requiring review and approval by the Energy Facility Siting Board.

Intervention in PUC proceedings is governed by PUC Rule 1.13. Since Invenergy's proposed generating facility will be connected to National Grid's transmission line and switching station, National Grid is seeking intervention pursuant to PUC Rule 1.13(b)(2) as its interests are

directly affected by this proceeding, are not adequately represented by the existing parties, and the PUC's decision in this proceeding may be binding on National Grid.¹

WHEREFORE, National Grid hereby respectfully requests to be granted leave to intervene in this proceeding as a full party.
