## NOTICE OF TECHNICAL RECORD SESSION

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws §§ 39-1 and 42-46-6, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will conduct Technical Record Session on <u>Wednesday, January 11, 2017 @ 9:30 A.M.</u> in Hearing Room A at the PUC's office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. At this technical session, The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid will present and explain the details of the Company's proposal to amend its Net Metering Tariff Provision to reflect changes to R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.4-2 and § 39-26.4-3 (Net Metering Law). Specifically, the Company seeks to amend the tariff to implement the statutory provisions regarding the Community Remote Net Metering Pilot (Pilot), which went into effect on June 27, 2016.

The Net Metering Law requires the Company to implement a 30 megawatt (MW) Community Remote Net Metering Pilot between now and December 31, 2018. Under the Pilot, residential customers and low and moderate income customers may receive net metering credits from remote systems. The Pilot is limited to a 30MW capacity limit. The proposed changes to the Net Metering Tariff provides eligibility requirements and threshold criteria for applicants to qualify for the Pilot.

National Grid's filing may be examined at the PUC's office. The filing can also be accessed at <u>www.ripuc.org/eventsactions/docket/4631page.html</u>. Reference is made to Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws.
