COMM-1-1 Please identify the maximum price Pascoag Utility District is willing to pay per kWh for the 0.5 MW of output from the proposed ISM Solar Development, LLC project.

Response: Pascoag Utility District is willing to pay 7 cents/kWh for any production from ISM for up to a 0.5 MW supply.

COMM-1-2 Is Pascoag willing to pay higher than market price at any time during the term of the contract?

Response: Yes, in order to help make this project economically viable for ISM and Pascoag’s desire to encourage renewable energy in our service territory, the price of 7 cents/kWh is currently above market price, but acceptable to Pascoag for a modest entitlement in an environmentally friendly power supply.
