The Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has completed its review of the documentation submitted on behalf of WED Coventry Two Generation Unit (Facility) on July 6, 2017 regarding the Town of Warwick (Applicant) Facility's assigned GIS identification number.¹ The supplied information received on July 6, 2017 notified that the Facility was assigned NEPOOL-GIS Asset Identification Number MSS 49412 in accordance with Commission Order No. 22643.²

Commission Staff has determined that the supplied documentation is acceptable and is in conformance with Commission Order No. 22643 in Docket No. 4645 certifying the WED Coventry Two, LLC Facility as an Eligible, New Wind Renewable Energy Resource having a combined nameplate capacity of 4.5 MW. Commission Staff has assigned to the WED Coventry Two Generation Unit the unique Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission Eligible Renewable Energy Resource Facility Certification Number RI-4645-N17. Renewable Energy Certificates associated with the production of energy from the Facility, which are minted on or after their inclusion within ISO-NE's Quarter Two 2017 Power System Model Release, are eligible for the Rhode Island Renewable Energy Standard.

¹ The Asset Name was listed as West Warwick Cov Wind.

² Commission Order No. 22643 issued in Docket Nos. 4649, 4645, 4650 and 4662, certified that ten generation units having a total nameplate capacity of 15 MW meet the requirements for eligibility as a Renewable Energy Resource. The entire 15 MW facility comprised of the following facilities: WED Coventry Two, LLC; WED Coventry Five, LLC; WED Coventry Six, LLC; Coventry 1; Coventry 3; and Coventry 4. The generation units were all associated with GIS Asset ID Number MSS 47751. The Commission instructed the Applicant to remodel the generators and replace the single generation unit GIS Asset ID Number MSS 47751 with three separate and distinct GIS Asset ID Numbers. The previously assigned GIS identification number MSS 47751 was retired due to the remodeling of the generation units.
