NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws §39-3-11, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will conduct a hearing on **Monday, December 12, 2016 at 9:30 A.M.** in a Hearing Room A at the PUC's office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island.

At this hearing, the PUC will examine the propriety of a proposal by the Pascoag Utility District (Pascoag) for approval to implement rate changes that arise out of the utility's reconciliation of its tariff adjustment provisions for the Standard Offer Service Rate, Transition Service Charge and Transmission Service Charge effective January 1, 2017. Specifically, Pascoag seeks to implement the following rate changes: 1) to increase the Standard Offer Service Rate from \$0.05401 per kWh to \$0.05887 per kWh, 2) to increase the Transition Service Charge from \$0.00957 per kWh to \$0.01024 per kWh, and 3) to increase the Transmission Service Charge from \$0.03081 per kWh to \$0.03211 per kWh. The combined net impact of the proposed rate changes on a typical residential customer's bill using 500 kWh per month would result in an increase of \$2.30 from \$72.85 to \$75.15. The PUC can approve different rates that may be higher or lower than those proposed by Pascoag. The PUC will also undertake a review of Pascoag's 2017 supply procurement portfolio pursuant to R.I.G.L. §39-1-27.8.

The proposal may be examined at the PUC's office. The filing can also be accessed under the PUC's Docket Menu at [www.ripuc.org](http://www.ripuc.org), Docket No. 4664. Reference is made to Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws.
