Request:

What were the annual revenues generated from National Grid's partnership with EnergySage under the SolarWise program? What are the anticipated revenues going forward?

Response:

For activity in the program year ending March 2017, National Grid's share of revenue from the partnership with EnergySage is \$ 2,892.33. For activity in the 2017 program year, commencing April 1, 2017 through current, the Company has not yet received any revenues. The revenue for National Grid for the remainder of this program year will be based on the amount of solar sold through the Marketplace, both as it exists today and as it will be if these program modifications are approved. The Company cannot reasonably forecast this quantity at this time, as the start date and response rate to the Marketplace marketing plan are unknown. The Company will gain experience with the new program model and marketing plan over the remainder of this program year, which should inform future estimations of this revenue.
