This report of The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid (National Grid or the Company) is filed with the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission (PUC) in compliance with its bench decision at the hearing on February 17, 2017 in Docket No. 4676, which required the Company to file the following annual reports (1) annual report every March 15 containing the Forward Capacity Market (FCM) auction results; and (2) annual report every July detailing the performance of the facilities in the FCM. The PUC identified the following items for inclusion in the March 15 annual report:

1. Description of the facilities that were bid.
2. Description of which facilities received a Capacity Supply Obligation.
3. The clearing price.

Pursuant to the PUC's decision in the above-referenced docket, National Grid is providing the following results regarding the Forward Capacity Auction ("FCA") 13 that occurred on February 4, 2019.

3. FCA-13 cleared at a price of \$3.800/kW-month for the Rest-of-Pool zone, which includes Rhode Island. All resources that obtained a Capacity Supply Obligation will earn this payment rate for the months of June 2022 – September 2022.
