RE: Docket 4676 - Proposed National Grid Proposal to Bid Capacity of Customer-Owned DG Facilities into the Forward Capacity Market Revised Proposal

Dear Ms. Massaro:

National Grid¹ and staff from the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (Division) have continued to discuss the outstanding issues in the above-referenced docket as presented in the pre-filed direct testimony of Richard S. Hahn of Daymark Energy Advisors filed on behalf of the Division, to which the Company responded in its rebuttal testimony. The Company and the Division have reached an agreement regarding a revised proposal, the terms of which are as follows:

- 90/10 incentive sharing allocation (90 percent to customers and 10 percent to the Company) of Net FCM Proceeds, either positive or negative. Net FCM Proceeds is defined in the Company's original filing as all payments received from ISO-NE for participation in the FCM, net of ISO-NE fees, charges, or penalties that may be assessed under FCM market rules.
- Full administrative cost recovery through the RE Growth and LTCRER recovery and
 reconciliation factors, as originally proposed in the Company's filing, with the added
 objective to eventually roll any recurring labor costs into base rates. To the extent there
 are other administrative costs that are incremental (i.e., the nature of which not being
 recovered in base rates at the time the costs are incurred), the Company would continue
 to propose recovery of those costs through the factors provided for in the respective tariff
 provisions.
- No deferral of administrative costs.
- No cap on administrative costs, with the understanding that such costs will be subject to PUC review in a separate filing.

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No RFP requirement for the first year, with the acknowledgement that the Company will
continue to assess the options in the market in the event that additional resources are
needed in the second year or beyond.

The Company has consulted with Division staff regarding this submittal, and they have indicated their concurrence with the terms and representations contained herein. Accordingly, the Company presents the above revised proposal for the PUC's consideration in this proceeding.
