

The Division, OER and State Planning (“State Parties”) do not take any position with respect to the Town of Burrillville’s Motion for Stay and leave the decision regarding the length and scope of the requested stay to the Commission. The State Parties have forwarded discovery addressed to National Grid and CRE. Responses are due at the end of December, 2017. The State Parties request that whenever the Commission decides that any proposed stay will expire, the Commission will set a discovery schedule and a new deadline for providing the State Parties’ recommendation to the Commission. The applicants will require additional time to provide their responses to the State Parties, and the State Parties may have further discovery for National Grid and CRE.
