The Division is requesting that the Commission extend the suspension period of the proposed petition of National Grid in the above entitled matter for an additional (30) days to afford the Division ample time to gather outstanding discovery and prepare reply comments to the Petition in the instant docket.

The grounds for this request is that Division, now has transmitted (7) seven sets of data requests to National Grid, the last set of data requests transmitted to the Company on August 20, 2018. Presently, the Division is working with the company to resolve outstanding discovery.
