NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

Pursuant to Rule 1.12(c)¹ of the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission’s (PUC) Rules of Practice and Procedure, National Grid² respectfully withdraws its Notification of an Energy Incentive Greater Than \$3,000,000 (Notification), which the Company filed with the PUC on May 31, 2018. National Grid withdraws the Notification for the following reasons:

1. To date, the Company has responded to approximately ten sets of data requests from the Rhode Island Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (Division).
2. In response to the Division’s request, the PUC has suspended indefinitely its consideration of the Notification to permit the Division to continue its fact gathering regarding the project that is the subject of the Notification.
3. The Company withdraws the Notification so it can collaborate with the Division and the customer regarding the project that is the subject of the Notification.
4. The Company will re-file the Notification with the PUC at a later date.
5. The Division is aware that the Company is filing this Notice of Withdrawal.
