NOTICE OF TECHNICAL RECORD SESSION

Pursuant to the provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws §39-3-11, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will conduct a technical session on **Tuesday, November 28, 2017 @ 9:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A of the PUC's office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island

In this docket The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a National Grid (Company) submitted a tariff advice to request approval of Company's electric tariff, entitled Standards for Connecting Distributed Generation, RIPUC No. 2180. Specifically, the Company seeks to amend the tariff to implement the recent amendments to the Distributed Generation Interconnection Standards pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.3-4.1 (DG Interconnection Standards). The amendments are designed to, *inter alia*, limit the ways in which the Company can charge renewable energy customers for system modifications to interconnect to the electric distribution system. The amended law also places certain timeframes on the Company to complete the application process and all system modifications, and enables the replacement of an existing renewable energy resource with limitations on study time and system modification costs. Accordingly, National Grid seeks to amend its electric tariff consistent with the amendments to the DG Interconnection Standards. At this technical session, National Grid will go through and explain the proposed changes to the tariff.

The proposal is available for examination at the PUC's office. The filing can also be accessed under <http://www.ripuc.org/eventsactions/docket/4763page.html>. Reference is made to Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws.
