NOTICE OF ORAL ARGUMENTS

Laws § 42-46-6(b) and 39-1-1, the Public Utilities Commission's (PUC) hereby gives notice that on **Wednesday, February 14, 2018 at 1:00 PM**, in Hearing Room A at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island, it will conduct a hearing for the purpose of taking oral arguments on the certain Petitions for Intervention in the instant dockets to which The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid (National Grid) has objected. These dockets pertain to National Grid's request to increase its electric and gas distribution rates and proposal to implement certain power sector transformation elements and the associated cost recovery.
