**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to Rhode Island Gen. Laws § 39-3-11, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will conduct hearing on **Friday, September 21, 2018 @ 9:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A at the PUC's office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. The hearing will be streamed live at <http://www.ustream.tv/channel/WqQyXw296dg>.

At this hearing the PUC will examine the propriety of filing by National Grid (Company) seeking approval to implement revised Renewable Energy (RE) Growth Factors and RE Growth Reconciliation Factors effective October 1, 2018. In accordance with the REG Growth Provision, the RE Growth Factors are designed to recover an estimate of the costs the Company expects to incur during the current Program Year of April 2018 through March 2019. The filing also includes the annual RE Growth Program reconciliation of actual RE Growth revenue for the period April 2017 through May 2018, estimated revenue for the period June 2018 through September 2018, and actual costs incurred to administer the RE Growth Program during the period April 2017 through March 2018. The impact of the proposal on a monthly bill of a residential Standard Offer Service (SOS) customer using 500 kWh is an increase of \$0.84, or approximately 0.8%. The PUC may rule immediately at the end of the hearing.

National Grid's filing is available for examination at the PUC's office. The docket can also be accessed at <http://www.ripuc.org/eventsactions/docket/4847page.html>. Reference is also made to Chapters 42-35 and 39-1 of the Rhode Island General Laws.
