NOTICE OF TECHNICAL RECORD SESSION

Pursuant to the provisions of the R.I. Gen. Laws §§39-1-1 and 42-46-6, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will conduct a Technical Record Session on **Tuesday, May 14, 2019, at 9:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A at the PUC's office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. The Technical Record Session will be streamed live at <http://www.ustream.tv/channel/WqQyXw296dg>.

As part of its decision in Docket No. 4770, In re: The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid Electric and Gas Distribution Rate Filing, the PUC rejected the Capital Efficiency Mechanism from the Settlement and opened this docket pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-1-27.7.1(e)(3) to investigate adopting this mechanism as a performance metric in the Electric Infrastructure, Safety, and Reliability Plan. On April 10, 2019, the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers submitted a revised capital efficiency mechanism design. On May 3, 2019, The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid filed responsive testimony. At this Technical Session, the PUC will review the technical and policy issues raised by the revised mechanism.
