ORDER

WHEREAS, On November 8, 2018, JO RI Solar, LLC¹ (Company) filed with the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission (PUC) an application seeking certification for its Johnston Generation Unit, a 3.0 MW AC (4.057 MW DC) solar energy Generation Unit located in Johnston, Rhode Island, as an eligible New Renewable Energy Resource in accordance with the PUC's Rules and Regulations Governing the Implementation of a Renewable Energy Standard (Rules) and R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26-1; and

WHEREAS, The application identified AlsoEnergy, Inc. as the independent verifier for verifying and reporting appropriate billing records from the Company's Generation Unit to the NEPOOL Generation Information System (GIS); and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 6.0 and other relevant Sections of the Rules, a thirty-day period for public comment was provided during which time no such comments were received; and

WHEREAS, Supplemental and clarifying information was provided to PUC Staff and their application review consultant from January 3, 2019 through February 6, 2019 in response to the application review consultant's requests for said information from December 23, 2018 through January 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Said supplemental and clarifying information included: a) clarification regarding the name of the Generation Unit, b) clarification regarding the

contact information for the primary contact, c) clarification regarding the contact information for the backup contact, d) clarification regarding the capacity of the Generation Unit, and e) a completed *Appendix D: Special Provisions for Aggregators of Customer-Sited or Off-grid Generation Facilities*; and

WHEREAS, After examination, the PUC is of the opinion that the application is proper, reasonable, and in compliance with the Rules and hereby grants the Company certification as an eligible renewable energy resource pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26-1; and

WHEREAS, As a grid-connected (virtual net-metered) facility, sufficient documentation was included in the supplemental information to confirm the independence of the verifier, the PUC hereby approves AlsoEnergy, Inc. as an independent verifier; and

WHEREAS, The PUC's determination in this docket is based on the information submitted by the Company and the PUC may reverse its ruling or revoke the Company's certification if any material information provided by the Company proves to be false or misleading.

Accordingly, it is

(23424) ORDERED:

1) The Johnston Generation Unit meets the requirements for eligibility as a New, Solar Renewable Energy Resource with its 3.0 MW AC (4.057 MW DC), Grid-Connected Generation Unit having a Commercial Operation Date of November 8, 2018 and located within the NEPOOL control area in Johnston, Rhode Island.

2) The Generation Unit's NEPOOL-GIS Identification Number is NON123738.

3) The Company's Generation Unit as identified above is hereby assigned unique certification number RI-4897-N19.

4) The facility's Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) become Rhode Island-eligible effective on the first day which the Rhode Island certification number is issued. All RECs associated with the production of eligible energy that are minted on or after the Effective Date are eligible for the Renewable Energy Standard.

5) AlsoEnergy, Inc. meet the requirements for approval as a Rhode Island Independent Verifier.

6) Although the PUC will rely upon the NEPOOL GIS for verification of production of energy from the Company's Generation Unit certified as eligible in this Order, the Company will provide information and access as necessary to the PUC, or persons acting at its behest, to conduct audits or site visits to assist in verification of continued eligibility for and compliance with Rhode Island Renewable Energy Standard Certification at any time at the PUC's discretion.

7) The Company shall notify the PUC in the event of a change in the facility's eligibility status.

NOTICE OF RIGHT OF APPEAL: Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-5-1, any person aggrieved by a decision or order of the PUC may, within seven days from the date of the order, petition the Supreme Court for a Writ of Certiorari to review the legality and reasonableness of the decision or order.
