## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS**

Pursuant to the provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws §39-3-11, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) hereby gives notice that it will conduct hearings to examine the propriety of proposals submitted by The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a National Grid to implement rate changes. The hearings will be held in Hearing Room A, at the PUC's office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island on the following date and time. March 19, 2019 @ 9:30 A.M. – In Docket No. 4930, National Grid proposes rate changes arising out of the Company's annual reconciliations of Standard Offer Service (SOS), the SOS administrative costs, the non-bypassable transition charge, the transmission service charge, the transmission-related uncollectible expense, the Net Metering charge and the Long-Term Contracting (LTC) for the Renewable Energy Factor. The tariff provisions provide for the reconciliation and recovery of actual revenues and expenses incurred by the Company for the period January 2018 through December 2018 and estimated revenues and expenses projected to be incurred from April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020. The bill impact for a residential customer who receives Standard Offer Service and uses 500 kWh a month is a decrease of \$3.07 or 2.6%. percent.

March 19, 2019 @ 1:00 P.M. – In Docket No. 4809, the Company proposes a Renewable Energy Standard Charge of \$0.00063 per kWh arising out of the reconciliation and calculation of the Renewable Energy Standard Charge for the compliance period ending December 31, 2018. The bill impact for a residential customer who receives Standard Offer Service and uses 500 kWh a month is an increase of \$0.31, or 0.3%.

The combined net effect of the proposed rate changes on a typical residential Standard Offer Service customer using 500 kWh per month is a decrease of \$2.76 from \$118.51 to \$115.75 or 2.3% for effect April 1, 2019. The PUC may approve different rates that may be higher or lower than those proposed by National Grid. The PUC may rule immediately at the end of the hearing.

The filings and proposed rate changes may be examined at the PUC's office.
