The Episcopal Diocese of Rhode Island appreciates the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission's mediation of its dispute in Docket 4973 and particularly its assistance with the settlement acknowledged in the mediator's December 30, 2019 report to the Commission. The Diocese does not accept the mediator's recommendations with the exception of the recommendation that each party shall pay its costs of dispute resolution. The Diocese does not request further adjudication by the Commission under section 9.3 of Tariff 2163, Standards for Connecting Distributed Generation.

The Diocese will pay Narragansett's impact study fee for the Affected System Operator Study subject to its Appeal of the Commission's decision in docket 4981.
