Request:

RR-2. For Massachusetts, please provide the costs (plus or minus) associated with the socialization of the billing adjustment up through the most recent date. Please include the amount of kwh and dollars.

Response:

The socialization of Massachusetts Basic Service billing adjustments for residential and commercial customers began in April 2015. Billing adjustments for industrial customers are not socialized. Following are two tables which show the kWh and amounts of Massachusetts Basic Service billing adjustments from January 2018 through June 2020. The Company has provided amounts related to municipal aggregations as well as individual customers leaving Basic Service for competitive supply. The Company has now compiled the data prior to January 2018 and is supplementing the original response with the additional data, shown below.
