
MOTION TO INTERVENE

Now comes the Kent County Water Authority ("KCWA") who hereby moves to intervene in the within matter. KCWA submits that, as a wholesale purchaser of Providence Water Supply Board's ("PWSB") water, KCWA has an interest that will be directly affected and which is not represented by any existing party to in this proceeding. KCWA is a Public Water Authority created and existing pursuant to Public Laws 1946-Chapter 1740. Pursuant to PWSB's notice filed in the within matter, PWSB seeking a multi-year plan that would increase rates in three phases. The first phase seeks to increase its wholesale water rates by 20.67%. This is an increase in the wholesale water fees of \$373.26 per million gallons from the current wholesale fees. The proposed second phase increases the wholesale rates by 7.26%, which is an increase in wholesale water rates of \$158.16 per million gallons from the current wholesale fees. The proposed third phase increases water rates by 3.94%. This is an increase in wholesale water fees of \$92.20 per million gallons from the current wholesale fees. In order to satisfy the proposed PWSB rate, KCWA will be required to pass on all or a portion of any rate increase to those residents, industries and businesses whom KCWA provides water. As result, KCWA and its customers will be directly affected by PWSB's proposed rate increase, and such interests are

not adequately represented by existing party to this proceeding. (R.I. Gen. Laws 45-6-1 (1999 & Supp. 2008) (Rule 1.13 PUC Rules of Practice and Procedure).

For these reasons and pursuant to PUC Rule 1.13, KCWA respectfully requests the PUC grant its Motion to Intervene.
