- A. The WWD plans to commence the following with respect to outreach:
  - 1. Send reminder letters to delinquent water customers. The letters will highlight the following:
    - Balance Owed and payment methods (mailing address, lockbox, credit card)
    - If a customer is not able to pay the balance due, the letter will request the customer contact the City's Collection Specialists for payment agreement options.
  - 2. Thirty (30) days following the delivery of the reminder letters, the WWD will look at the effectiveness of the letters and determine the best way to proceed with further public outreach, including additional collection notices and water shutoffs, consistent with the PUC's latest COVID related Orders and the PUC's Rules and Regulations Governing Termination of Residential Electric, Natural Gas, and Water Utility Service.
