1. Are there any tickets outstanding and unused from previously sold frequent user booklets and volume discounts? If so, how will these be handled?

AMENDED RESPONSE:

There are tickets outstanding and unused from frequent user booklets sold last year. However, there are no volume discount tickets outstanding and unused because they are good only for the date printed on them.

Interstate will honor outstanding and unused frequent user tickets sold last year. The tickets will have to be exchanged at the ticket window before getting on the boat in order to be honored.

Those holding the tickets need to be aware that, due primarily to the COVID-19 capacity restrictions, they may not be able to board the fast ferry if all available seats are occupied with passengers who made online reservations or who arrived at the ticket window ahead of them. In that case, the passengers will be offered the option to take the next available traditional ferry using the discount ticket or to wait for the next available fast ferry. Interstate will post a sign to this effect at the ticket window and will post a notice to this effect on its website.
