Record Request No. 1

Request:

What portion of the total proposed gas costs is attributable to the rate increase proposed by Columbia Gas that is pending before FERC?

Response:

The total proposed gas costs include the rates proposed by Columbia beginning in February 2021, with current rates in effect from November 2020 through January 2021. While proposed pipeline reservation rates (fixed costs) are increasing, proposed variable transport and storage rates are decreasing relative to the rates that are currently effective.

Regarding fixed costs, the <u>increase</u> is \$249,779 per month or \$2,248,010 from February 2021 through October 2021. This represents 1.5% of the \$147,455,300 of total proposed gas costs included on page 1 of Attachment GSP-1 Second Revision.

Regarding variable costs, the <u>decrease</u> is approximately \$5,300 from February 2021 through October 2021. This represents 0.004% of the \$147,455,300 of total proposed gas costs included on page 1 of Attachment GSP-1 Second Revision.

In total, the increase is approximately \$2,242,710 or 1.5% of total proposed gas costs.
