(The total SRP budget proposed is \$0.00 and the proposed SRP factor is an incremental charge of \$0.0000 per kWh to the energy efficiency factor.) At this Technical Session the PUC will continue to discuss and examine the SRP Plan and Year-End Report. The PUC expects the participants to be prepared to address the topics in the below Agenda.
