On behalf of the Pascoag Utility District, I would like to file an original and nine copies of our request to reallocate funds within the approved budget for 2021. This submission is made to the Division and Commission for their review and approval, pursuant to the budget transfer rules approved in this docket.

The District's Home Energy Audits with Weatherization Incentives program has had a very productive year. Currently the available balance of the program is \$10,176.08 with several weatherization projects in the process of being completed and home energy audits scheduled out into October. The District believes the funds for this program will be depleted shortly and still has customers interested in completing weatherization projects.

The District would like to propose reallocating funds from several currently underutilized programs in order to rebate those customers who would like to complete weatherization projects before the end of the year.

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Pascoag Utility District is happy to report that the Home Energy Audits with Weatherization Incentives program has been very successful this year. Presently, the District has a balance of \$27,590.71 left in the Residential Weatherization program budget. There are six weatherization projects that will be completed before the end of the month which will further reduce the balance by \$17,414.63, leaving \$10,176.08 remaining. Energy audits and direct installs that have been completed in August and September have not been invoiced to the District yet. We estimate that the total of both invoices will be roughly \$4,000 which will leave a balance of \$6,176.08 to fund any remaining audits and direct installs that occur in October, November and December.

As we still have roughly three and a half months left of the year, we'd like to reallocate funds from programs that are underutilized this year, to the Home Energy Audits with Weatherization Incentives program. The District proposes reallocating the following:

- DR2105 Committed for 2020 Programs-The District would like to reallocate the balance of \$1,125.00 from this program. All 2020 rebates have been processed at this time so this program is closed.
- DA2103 Program Research and Development-The District would like to reallocate the balance of \$500.00 from this program. We do not anticipate a need to use these funds for research and development before the end of the year.
- DC2101 Outreach/Education-The District would like to reallocate \$5,285.00 from Outreach/Education. As
 many of our regularly scheduled events have not been held this year, we have not had to purchase as
 many energy efficiency fulfilment materials or allocate staff time to this outreach channel. We've been
 mainly advertising programs through local publications, handouts in the office, and billing inserts.
- DC2103 Community Events- We'd like to reallocate \$6,408.00 from the Community Events budget. When submitting our filing in 2020, we were hopeful that we'd be getting back to promoting our DSM program through our regular schedule of community events by the summer of 2021. Unfortunately, many of the events have been cancelled and as COVID-19 cases have increased with the Delta variant, we've made the choice not to attend large indoor events for the safety of our staff. The District knew this might be a possibility when we proposed the 2021 budget but wanted to remain as flexible as possible given the ever changing situation we face. We still feel that community events are a valuable and important way to engage with our customers and promote the DSM program and look forward to being able to safely do so again in the future.
- DC2104 Energy Efficiency Management Continuing Education-The District would like to reallocate \$1,000 from this program. The District's DSM Coordinator has mainly attended free webinars and has not traveled

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in-person to any offsite conferences so there has been less expenses for this program than in previous years.

If these reallocations are approved, it would total \$14,318.00 and would help fund five more weatherization projects before the end of the year. Three additional customers have already been in contact with the District and would like to pursue completing weatherization projects before the cold weather sets in. We've held off giving them approval to move forward with these projects as funds in this program are depleted. The District is submitting various exhibits supporting these changes and this overview will highlight what is being proposed.

We respectfully ask for your expeditious review of our request and the approval of the fund transfer as presented here so that we can ensure all PUD customers are able to implement these important energy efficiency services this year.
