## ORDER (Third Enrollment)

The Renewable Energy Growth Program<sup>1</sup> is a tariff-based financing program for renewable distributed energy generation systems. The program is only available under The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid (National Grid) tariffs.<sup>2</sup> The purpose of the program is to facilitate and encourage the installation and development of renewable distributed generation systems, reduce environmental impacts and carbon emissions, diversify generation sources, stimulate economic development, improve distribution system resilience and reliability, and reduce distribution system costs.<sup>3</sup> Annually, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) reviews and approves an enrollment schedule, technology targets, and ceiling prices against which commercial and large scale projects compete for participation in the Renewable Energy Growth Program. The program year runs from April 1<sup>st</sup> to the following March 31<sup>st</sup>. The 2021 Renewable Energy Growth Program targets and ceiling prices were approved on February 18 and March 29, 2021.<sup>4</sup>

R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.6-20(b) requires the PUC to review and issue Certificates of Eligibility for commercial scale and large-scale projects that have been chosen by National Grid

for participation in the Renewable Energy Growth Program. Following each enrollment, National Grid files an Enrollment Report. Pursuant to the R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.6-20(b), National Grid filed the Third Enrollment Report for Program Year 2021 on December 21, 2021. National Grid reported that it had selected three projects for PUC approval, for a total nameplate capacity of 6,070 kW. National Grid reported that it had selected one commercial scale solar project, one commercial scale solar carport project, and one large scale solar project. National Grid requested the PUC award Certificates of Eligibility for all three projects.<sup>5</sup>

On January 12, 2022, the PUC reviewed and approved the Certificates of Eligibility, finding that the project was consistent with the applicable Renewable Energy Growth tariff enrollment rules.
