- 1. Your opinion regarding whether the information currently contained in the final accounting:
  - a. is presented clearly;
  - b. contains enough detail;
  - c. conforms to industry standards (we emphasize the need for specific information on why or why not is);
  - d. why any additional information would beneficial, specifying the information and level of detail (e.g., solves a problem, improves efficiency, etc.);
- 2. Your opinion regarding:
  - a. what information is not contained in the final accounting (excluding incremental detail to existing information described above);
  - b. how this information should be presented;
  - c. why this information would beneficial (e.g., solves a problem, improves efficiency, etc.).
- 3. If there is a format or practice from another electric distribution company in a state where you have developed a DG project that you prefer, please provide an example from a real project and rationale for why it is better and what problem(s) it solves. You may redact competitively sensitive information.
