**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to the provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws §39-3-11, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will conduct a hearing on **Tuesday, March 15, 2022 @ 9:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A at the PUC's office, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. The hearing will be streamed live at <https://video.ibm.com/channel/WqQyXw296dg>.

In this docket, the PUC will examine the propriety of a filing by The Narragansett Electric d/b/a National Grid (Company) for approval of proposed Gas Infrastructure, Safety and Reliability Plan for fiscal year 2023 (ISR Plan). The ISR Plan is submitted pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-1-27.7.1 which provides for an annual gas infrastructure, safety and reliability spending plan for each fiscal year and an annual rate reconciliation mechanism that includes a reconcilable allowance for the anticipated capital investments and other spending pursuant to an annual pre-approved budget. The ISR Plan sets forth proposals the Company has identified as necessary to sustain and enhance the safety and reliability of its gas distribution system. The Company's Gas ISR Plan for FY 2023 proposes capital spending that reflects an incremental revenue requirement of \$4,195,084 above the FY 2022 ISR Plan which will be collected through the Distribution Adjustment Charge (DAC) effective April 1, 2022. The annual impact on an average residential heating customer using 845 therms per year, is an annual increase of \$10.98 or 0.8%.

The proposal is available for examination at the PUC's office. The filing can also be accessed under the PUC's website at <http://www.ripuc.ri.gov/eventactions/docket/5210page.html>. Reference is made to Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws.
