Response:

NBC plans to file an application with the RIPUC for rate relief in the fall of 2022 for new rates effective July 1, 2023. As part of that application, NBC will include electronic payment transaction fees ("fees") expense as it would any other expense.

If, in the event that NBC does not file such an application, the NBC is not opposed to an annual true-up. NBC believes that any associated rate adjustment should be greater than \$10,000, which is the approximate cost to ratepayers for such an application.
