**PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**April 12, 2011** – SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

**April 26, 2011** - NATIONAL GRID, ADVOCACY SECTION AND PORTSMOUTH TO JOINTLY SUBMIT AN “AGREED-UPON STATEMENT OF FACTS.”

**JUNE 10, 2011** – DEADLINE FOR FILING LEGAL MEMORANDA (NO PRE-FILED TESTIMONY OR HEARING NECESSARY).

MEMORANDA MUST ADDRESS THE FOLLOWING TWO QUESTIONS (Consistent with Riggs’ Complaint - repeated in Advocacy Section’s 2/2/11 legal memorandum):

1. Whether the Town of Portsmouth is receiving an excessive rate for the output it sells back to National Grid?
2. Whether the Town of Portsmouth’s Wind Facility is a net metering configuration or a wholesale generator according to federal law?

**JULY 22, 2011** – DEADLINE FOR FILING REPLY MEMORANDA
