**DIV 2-1**

The provisions of R.I.G.L. **39-26.1-9. Town of Johnston Project.** – provide inter alia

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter to the contrary:

(1) The Narragansett Electric Company is hereby authorized, at its sole discretion, to procure a commercially reasonable long-term contract for a newly developed renewable energy

resource fueled by landfill gas from the central landfill in the town of Johnston on a timetable

earlier than is otherwise set forth in this chapter.

(2) Any such contract executed on or before May 21, 2010 shall be legal, binding and enforceable and shall not be subject to commission approval if:

(i) Such resource has a gross nameplate capacity rating of less than thirty-seven (37) megawatts;

please explain in detail whether the proposed project which is the subject of this matter complies with the gross nameplate capacity rating of less than thirty-seven (37) megawatts set-forth in RIGL 39-26.1-9(2)(i) and if so, how GENCO reconciles the representations made at the following Tabs of GENCO’s June 15 2010 filing described as follows:

Tab 16, p. 1 referencing a 42 MW plant;

Tab 17, p. 1, referencing a 42 MW power plant;

Tab 18, p. 3 referencing 41 MW facility;

Tab 20, p. 1referencinga 42 MW generation plant;

Tab 31, p. 7 referencing a plant with Gross MW 41.7 MW; Net MW37.3.
