Dear Attorney Licht and Director Galowitz,

In accordance with Chapter 14 of the 2010 Rhode Island Public Laws, it is the responsibility of the administrator of the Office of Energy Resources to review the purchase power agreement to determine whether it meets the goals set forth in Chapter 39-26.1 of the Rhode Island General Laws. In order to make an informed decision regarding whether or not the power purchase agreement does meet those stated goals, it is necessary to obtain documents responsive to the listed questions. I have indicated at the end of each question which entity is expected to supply the requested documents. As the statute has imposed a very short time period for review, it is imperative that these documents be provided forthwith.

- Documents demonstrating how the purchase power agreement will stabilize long term energy prices.
- Documents showing the number and type of jobs that will be created by building and operating the new facility as compared with the existing facility.
- Documents regarding the proposed use of federal tax credits for the new facility and how the use of federal tax credits provide an economic benefit to Rhode Island.
- Application and Project Approval by the Energy Facility Siting Board.
- Any agreements between the Town of Johnston and Rhode Island Resource Recovery Corporation or LFG Genco concerning this project, including any permits or approvals obtained for this project.
- Documents showing an estimate of the renewable energy that is expected to be produced by this new facility.

- Documents evidencing federal and state tax credits that may be claimed for the construction and operation of this facility.

Please provide the requested documentation to Ms. Luly Massaro, Division Clerk, Division of Public Utilities and Carriers, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island 02888. Please submit the requested documents by June 23, 2010.
