NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of the Rhode Island General Laws, §§ 39-1-1 and 39-3-3, as amended, the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers ("Division") will conduct a public hearing on **Tuesday, October 29, 2013 at 10:00 A.M.** in Hearing Room A of the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers, located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island.

At this hearing, the Division will examine the propriety of an application by A&R Marine Corporation d/b/a Prudence & Bay Islands Transport ("Applicant") for the issuance of a certificate of public convenience and necessity and authority to operate a ferry water carrier of passengers and freight between Bristol and Prudence Island.

Anyone wishing to protest the application must do so in accordance with the Division's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Anyone seeking Intervenor status for any hearing described above must file a Motion to Intervene in that matter, in writing, with the Division Clerk within seven (7) days after the date of Notice was given to the public by legal notice in the Providence Journal. The Motion must conform to the requirements of Rule 17 of the Division's Rules of Practice and Procedure available on the Division's web site at www.ripuc.org.

The application is on file for examination at the office of the Division. The application can also be accessed under the Division's Docket Menu at www.ripuc.org. Reference is made to Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35 of the RI General Laws. The Division of Public Utilities and Carriers is accessible to the handicapped. Individuals requesting interpreter services for the hearing impaired must notify the Clerk's office at 780-2107 seventy-two hours in advance of hearing date.
