**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws, § 39-1 et seq., the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (Division) will conduct a public hearing on **Thursday, June 23, 2016 at 10:00 A.M.** in a Hearing Room A of the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. The hearing may continue thereafter from day to day and time to time as required.

At this hearing, the Division will examine the propriety of an application by SeaStreak, LLC (Applicant) for the issuance of a certificate of public convenience and necessity and authority to operate as a seasonal water carrier of passengers. The Applicant seeks to provide water carrier services between points in Providence and Newport. The proposed ferry service is seasonal and will run from July 1, 2016 through September 5, 2016.

Anyone wishing to protest an application must do so in accordance with the Division Rules of Practice and Procedure. Anyone seeking Intervenor status for any hearing described above must file a Motion to Intervene in that matter, in writing, with the Division Clerk within seven (7) calendar days after the date Notice was given to the public by legal notice in the Providence Journal-Bulletin. The Motion must conform to the requirements of Rule 17 of the Division's Rules of Practice and Procedure (available on the Division's web site at [www.ripuc.org](http://www.ripuc.org)).

The Application is available for examination at the Division's office and can be accessed at [www.ripuc.org/eventsactions/docket/D\\_16\\_08.html](http://www.ripuc.org/eventsactions/docket/D_16_08.html). Reference is made to Rhode Island General Laws, Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35, specifically Sections 39-3-3 and 39-3-3.1.
