Verizon RI Interconnection Agreements (ICAs)

The following amendment to ICA was submitted for approval: 2546 - Amendment No. 1 to ICA entered between Verizon RI and RCN Operating Services f/k/a C-TEC Services, Inc.: The Division has reviewed the amendment and recommends approval.

After reviewed, Chairman Germani asked for a motion and Commissioner Racine moved to approve the amendment. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Holbrook and unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**

3591 – **Verizon Rhode Island:** Verizon submitted a tariff filing to introduce a new service offering called Asynchronous Transfer Mode Cell Relay Service (ATM-CRS), a high speed transport and switching service connectivity between and among customer designated locations, for effect April 1, 2004. After review, the Commission followed the Division's recommendation that the tariff filing be allowed to go into effect without suspension.

3569 – Investigation Into the Feasibility of Using Credit as a Method of Paying Utility Bills:

Ms. Wilson summarized the particulars of the proposed rules and after revisions, Commissioner Racine moved accept the rules as amended for public notice and comments. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Holbrook and unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.** A notice of the proposed rulemaking will be published on April 1 with a hearing on April 21. Comments will be accepted until May 3.

There being no further business to discuss, the open meeting adjourned at 2:35 P.M.
