Minutes of Open Meeting Held May 10, 2013

Attendees: Chairman Elia Germani, Commissioner Mary Bray, Cindy Wilson-Frias, Sharon Colby Camara, Dilip Shah and Luly Massaro. Commissioner Paul Roberti and staff Amy D'Alessandro, Patricia Lucarelli, Alan Nault and Nicholas Ucci were not present.

Chairman Germani called the open meeting to order at 10:00 A.M. in the first-floor hearing room of the Public Utilities Commission. A quorum was present.

Minutes of Open Meeting held on April 23, 2013, April 29, 2013 and May 1, 2013 – Chairman Germani moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Bray seconded the motion and the motion unanimously passed. **Vote 2-0.**

Competitive Telecommunications Service Providers

The following company filed an application for authority to transact as a telecommunication supplier. The Division has reviewed the application and recommended approval of

4407 – TNCI Operating Co., LLC

After review, Chairman Germani moved to approve the application. Commissioner Bray seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. **Vote 2-0.**

The following companies submitted tariff revision to their existing rates. The Division has reviewed the tariff filings and recommended that they be allowed to go into effect without suspension.

- 2618 – AT&T Corp. (tariff filing 5/1/13)
- 2262(E2) – Teleconnect Long Distance Services (tariff filing 5/1/13)

After review, the Commission followed the Division's recommendation that the tariff filings be allowed to go into effect without suspension.

4376 – Narragansett Bay Commission (Applicant) – The Applicant filed an application seeking certification for its Narragansett Bay Commission Field's Point Wind Turbines Generation Unit, a 4.5 MW Wind energy Generation Unit located in Providence, RI, as an eligible New Renewable Energy Resource. Commission's Consultant submitted a review and recommendation to approve the application. After review, Chairman Germani moved to approve the application. Commissioner Bray seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. **Vote 2-0.**

4403 – Camelot Wind LLOC (Applicant) - The Applicant Company filed an application seeking certification for its Camelot Wind Generation Unit, a 1.5 MW Wind energy Generation Unit located in Plymouth, MA, as an eligible New Renewable Energy Resource. Commission's Consultant submitted a review and recommendation to approve the application. After review, Chairman Germani moved to approve the application. Commissioner Bray seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. **Vote 2-0.**
