**Minutes of Open Meeting Held October 19, 2011**

**Chairman Germani called the open meeting to order at 10:00 A.M. in the first-floor hearing room of the Public Utilities Commission. A quorum was present.**

**Competitive Telecommunications Service Providers**

The following companies filed revisions to their existing tariffs. The Division has reviewed the tariff filings and recommends that they be allowed to go into effect without suspension:

2535 – Cox RI Telcom LLC (tariff filings 10/3 & 10/7/11)

4249 – YourTel America, Inc. (tariff filing 9/27/11)

2618 – AT&T Corp. (tariff filing 9)

3647 – XO Communications Services, Inc (tariff filings 9/29/11)

2262(K) – SNET America, Inc. (tariff filing 10/4/11)

2262(J20) – Embarq Communications, Inc. (tariff filing 10/3/11)

After review, the Commission followed the Division's recommendation that the tariff filings be allowed to go into effect without suspension.

**4289 – Verizon Rhode Island** – Verizon filed on September 30, 2011 a tariff filing to withdraw the Talking Call Waiting ancillary feature. The Division has reviewed the tariff filing and recommends that it be allowed to go into effect without suspension. After review, Commissioner Bray moved to approve Verizon's tariff filing. Commissioner Roberti seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**

**4258 – Littleville Power Co, Inc. (Company)** – The Company filed an application seeking certification for the Glendale Hydropower generation unit as an eligible Existing Renewable Energy Resource. After review, Commissioner Bray moved to approve the application. Commissioner Roberti seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**

**4257 – Littleville Power Co., Inc.** – The Company filed an application seeking certification for the Crescent Hydropower generation unit as an eligible Existing Renewable Energy Resource. After review, Commissioner Bray moved to approve the application. Commissioner Roberti seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**
