**Minutes of Open Meeting Held on September 14, 2018 @ 10:00 A.M.**

An Open Meeting of the Public Utilities Commission was held on September 14, 2018 at 10:00 A.M. in Hearing Room A, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island to discuss, deliberate and/or vote on the following dockets.

Present: Chairperson Margaret Curran, Commissioner Marion Gold, Commissioner Abigail Anthony, Todd Bianco and Luly Massaro.

- I. Chairperson Curran called the Open Meeting to order at 10:00 A.M. A quorum was present.
- II. **Docket No. 4813 – Narragansett Bay Commission** - The Narragansett Bay Commission submitted an application for eligibility certification of its Bucklin Point Biogas Engine I generation unit, a 0.644 MW AC (0.090 MW DC) biomass (fossil co-fired) facility located in East Providence, Rhode Island, as a New Renewable Energy Resource. After review, Chairperson Curran followed PUC consultant recommendation that eligibility be granted with the conditional requirement that the applicant submit evidence of Commercial Operation date when achieved and assignment of NEPOOL GIS Asset number. Commissioner Anthony seconded the motion and the motion unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**
- III. **Docket No. 4851 – 2600Hz, Inc. (Company)** – The Company submitted an application for registration to transact as a supplier of telecommunications service in Rhode Island. The Division recommended approval. Commissioner Gold seconded the motion and the motion unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**
