## Minutes of Open Meeting Held on June 30, 2020

An Open Meeting of the Public Utilities Commission was held on Tuesday, June 30, 2020 at 9:15 A.M. in Hearing Room A, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island to discuss, deliberate, and/or vote on the following dockets

In attendance: Commissioner Abigail Anthony and Todd Bianco. Remotely: Chairperson Margaret Curran, Commissioner Marion Gold, Patricia Lucarelli, Alan Nault and Luly Massaro.

- I. Chairperson Curran called to Open Meeting to order at 9:19 A.M. A quorum was present.
- II. **Docket No. 5030 The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a National Grid** The docket relates to the PUC's reviewed of National Grid annual Revenue Decoupling Mechanism (RDM) reconciliation for the 12-month period ending March 31, 2020 and associated RDM adjustment factor submitted on May 15, 2020 and subsequent revised filing to correct an error calculation submitted on June 25, 2020. National Grid requested approval of a proposed revised RDM adjustment factor of \$0.00118 per kWh applicable to all customers effective July 1, 2020. After review of the record, Chairperson Curran moved to approve the proposed RDM factor noting that the PUC is not ruling nor accepting the earning sharing calculation. Commissioner Gold seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**
- III. **Docket No. 5035 Ooma, Inc. (Company)** The Company filed on June 8, 2020 an application for registration to provide telecommunications service in Rhode Island. The Company also requested for protective treatment of financial information. After review, Chairperson Curran moved to approve the Company's registration and request for financial treatment of financial information included with the application. Commissioner Gold seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**
- IV. **Docket No. 4502 CenturyLink Public Communications, Inc. (Company)** The Company submitted notification that it has no customers and has ceased operations as a customer owned coin operated service provider in Rhode Island. The company requested to withdraw as a provider of telecommunications service. Chairperson Curran moved to grant the Company's request to cancel the Company's authorization as a customer owned coin operated service provider and institutional communications tariff. Commissioner Gold seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. **Vote 3-0.**
