ORDER

WHEREAS, On November 30, 1999, the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission

("Commission") issued Order No. 16063 approving a Settlement Agreement entered by and

between Valley Gas Company, Bristol & Warren Gas Company (collectively "Company")

and the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers ("Division") establishing a Supplemental

Low Income Energy Assistance Plan ("Plan"); and

WHEREAS, Under the Plan, the Company contributed \$240,000 funding level to

supplement heating assistance for customers eligible to receive grants from the Rhode Island

Energy Office Low Income Heating Emergency Assistance Program ("LIHEAP"); and

WHEREAS, The Plan was funded by the collection of a surcharge of \$0.028 per

Mcf applicable on firm sales and transportation customers for the period December 1, 1999

through November 30, 2000 and reimbursed to the Company; and

WHEREAS, On November 30, 2000, the Company filed with the Commission a

proposal to extend and expand the Plan through November 30, 2001, and to increase the

funding level up to \$285,000 to be collected through a surcharge of \$0.0364 per Mcf

effective on all firm sales and transportation customers effective with billing cycles in

December 2000; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, On December 14, 2000, the Division filed a memorandum supporting the Company's request to extend the Plan, increase the surcharge and funding level available to customers eligible to receive LIHEAP funds; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, At an open meeting on December 15, 2000, the Commission considered the Company's proposal and found it to be reasonable and in the best interests of ratepayers; and

Accordingly, it is

(16564) <u>ORDERED</u>:

The Valley Gas Company and Bristol & Warren Gas Company proposal to extend and expand the Supplemental Low Income Energy Assistance Plan is hereby approved, effective with cycle billings in December 2000.
